Multiple ThawSpaces

Deep Freeze allows for the creation of an unprotected space where data can be retained over restarts. Now up to eight different ThawSpaces can be created, providing greater flexibility to both users and IT.

Hidden ThawSpaces

ThawSpaces can now be designated as visible or hidden. Hidden ThawSpaces allow for application data or files to be stored in a hidden area, thereby discouraging end-user access or tampering.

Connect via Remote Desktop Connection (RDC)

Administrators can remote into a computer through Enterprise Console via Microsoft's Remote Desktop Protocol. RDC enables easy access, configuration, and control abilities on any networked computer.

Remote Execute

Remotely execute an executable file on a computer. Administrators do not have to visit each workstation to install a program, and reliance on third party management solutions is reduced.

Push and Install MSI

Push and install a .msi file on a computer. This allows administrators to use the Enterprise Console to install applications rather than scripting, GPOs, or using third party tools.

New Embedded Events Scheduler

The Embedded Events Scheduler now combines all possible Embedded Events into a single configuration tab which provides greater flexibility by enabling multiple events to be scheduled on a single day.

Faronics Licensing

Licensing has been added to Deep Freeze which allows for easy upgrades from evaluation to paid deployment.

Customizable Warning Messages

Customizable warning messages can now be displayed at the workstation prior to Maintenance, Restart, Shutdown, or Idle Time events and a separate customized message can be displayed during a Maintenance event. This gives users notification before the events take place.

Event Override Option

Users can optionally be allowed to cancel any Embedded Event (Maintenance, Restart, Shutdown, or Idle Time) prior to its execution on the workstation. This allows users to continue their workstation session uninterrupted.

Integrated Action Files

Action Files are now built into the Enterprise Console. Action Files call an external program or script through the Enterprise Console to reduce the need for third party tools. Administrators can use any scripting language that can be called through command line.

Wake-On-LAN Across Subnets

The Deep Freeze Enterprise Console can now wakeup computers across subnets on networks that are not C class.

Log Windows Updates

See which updates completed successfully by viewing the Deep Freeze log file.

Integrated Console Customizer

The Console Customizer which allowed custom versions of the Enterprise Console to be made is now built into the Enterprise Console. For example, teachers can be given a customized Enterprise Console that only allows them to restart computers, lock the keyboard and mouse on demand, and send messages to the students.

❖ System Requirements

Deep Freeze requires Windows 2000/XP/Vista and 10% free hard drive space. The Deep Freeze Configuration Administrator and the Enterprise Console require Windows 2000/XP/Vista to function properly. The hardware requirements are the same as the recommended requirements for the host operating system.
